What is a CCBHC?

Expands services of the RI CMHC model

- Breaks down access barriers
- Integrates primary care and behavioral health care
- Promotes collaboration with other agencies



Provides a comprehensive range of services to vulnerable individuals

 Gives each clinic the opportunity to determine what services are needed in their service areas

Prospective Payment System

 Medicaid provides an enhanced reimbursement rate based on each clinic's anticipated costs



CCBHCs Provide Nine Core Services Directly or Through Formal Partnerships

Why CCBHC?

New York

- 21% increase in Medicaid clients served in the first year
- All 13 CCBHCs eliminated wait lists
 - Increase in Staff
 Increase in Hours Increase in Access

Missouri

- 76% reduction in emergency department visits and hospitalizations
- 70% reduction in law enforcement involvement

Overall

- Hired an average of 117 new staff positions
- Increased clients by 17% in the first year
- Prospective Payment System (PPS) instrumental to the success of CCBHCs

SAMHSA Grant

Temporary

operational CCBHC


State Infrastructure Grant

State ARPA funds awarded to potential CCBHCs to build infrastructure State Legislation

Creates permanent CCBHC in RI, following federal model, with PPS payment in FY24 Federal Demonstration

10 states will be awarded increased Medicaid rate (FMAP) starting July 2024





New or Expanded RI Services

- Mobile Crisis 24/7/365
 - Responding in-person within 1 hour
- Open Access
 - No Wrong Door; Same Day Intake Appointment
- Outpatient Detox
- Evidence Based Programs with Fidelity Monitoring
 - 15 Required: ACT, MAT, MI, CBT, DBT, IDDT, SBIRT, CSC/HT, Zero Suicide, Trauma Informed Care, PSH/Housing First, IPS, 12-Step Facilitation, Family Psychoeducation, Seven Challenges
- Outreach & Engagement
- Services for Active Duty Military and Veterans





Rhode Island Legislation

FY 2023 (7/1/22-6/30/23)

- \$30 Million in ARPA funds awarded in state grants to build CCBHC infrastructure
- Legislation compelled the state to create sustainable CCBHCs with funding in FY24

FY 2024 (7/1/23-6/30/24)

 \$22.4 Million passed in Governor's Budget

FY 2025 (7/1/24-6/30/25)

• \$79.9 Million proposed in Governor's Budget




